

If you do not have a digital cable box, you still have two options to watch Colonie TV.

On July 23 of this year, Time-Warner Cable made all public, educational, and government channels exclusively digital.

For households who have in the past received ColonieTV, it remains in your package—but if you have an analog television, you either need a digital adapter or a digital TV to receive it. Adapters are available from Verizon and Time-Warner.

Once the adapter is installed, it will scan for the ColonieTV signal, locating it at 116.2 or just put in 116 and go up two stations.

If you have a digital television, you can just go to 116 and go up two stations to 116.2.
