Please follow these easy guidelines to help make your search a successful and enjoyable one.

Letterboxes have been HIDDEN because we want them to be there for others. They are not usually visible without moving leaves, pine needles, rocks etc... if they are an outdoor area. When you locate your letterbox, be sure to replace it EXACTLY as you have found it so that the next person will enjoy the hunt as much as you.

The Code of Conduct for letterboxing includes:

Leave no trace : While looking for a letterbox, remember to leave the area just as you found it.

Safety & security- dress and equip yourselves for the weather. Of course...Do not let children hunt for letterboxes unsupervised. And know the weather conditions and search accordingly. No one wants to get caught in a storm!

CROSSINGS PARK

Your trail starts at the Playground parking lot.

Locate the blue trail ⬠ in front of the tree maze. Follow the path towards the woods.

Stay to the right and continue on the blue trail ⬠ past the intersection.

As you enter the woods you will see a sign on your left. "The Forest Environment" – blue trail.

A short distance into the woods, you will see an intersection on your left.

Pass this intersection to a dirt path into the woods on your right. Follow the path a short distance.

Stay to the right when the trail forks to loop back around to the top of the small hill.

Find a grouping of small trees to your left. Your letterbox is behind them.

PRUYN HOUSE

Begin at the Burhmaster Barn.

Enter the trail from behind the schoolhouse (shorter) or to the right of the barn on Troop 279 K Willey E Trail (wood chip trail).

Note the trail markers on trees and posts. (They are simple wood blocks)

Continue on the trail following the trail markers, past a few small fallen trees on your left.

Continue as the path goes up a small hill.

At the top of the hill you will find a cluster of three 2-trunk trees on your right.

Your letterbox is behind the third 2-trunk tree.

COOK PARK

Whether you are a chef or cook this is the park where you want to look.
An amphitheater, fountain and pond. A new playground and baseball are found.
At the amphitheater for Frank A Leak begin the search for what you seek.
Standing stage-right you will see, the pond where fish or turtles may be.
Follow the path with a wood rail fence, up the hill on the left for further suspense.
Leave the theater behind and go into the park follow these clues to get home before dark.
A Summer flag decorates the light, follow dirt path with the flag on your right.
Hydrant on left & building on right, butterfly flag should be in your sight.
Trunks of four & trunks of three, between court and dog park I will be.
Look for a tree stump in the fence I am stuck, you should find me with any luck.
You're facing the cars that travel so fast. Near the base of my trunk you will find me at last.
